The universities and colleges of the state of Saxony-Anhalt founded the "EU University Network Saxony-Anhalt" at the beginning 2011.

The network provides information, consultation and project management services to support researchers in raising funds from the European Union and in executing EU research and innovation projects. The goal is to provide information about funding opportunities, to support applicants and to help in the management of EU projects. As a result of this cooperation, universities of Saxony-Anhalt shall be more successful in gathering funding for their research.

Target groups are researchers and research administrators of the network's universities who

- ▶ intend to participate in Horizon 2020 or Horizon Europe,
- ▶ prepare proposals as coordinator or project partner,
- ▶ have gained funding and seek support for project management,
- ▶ have general questions concerning EU research and EU research funding.

The network is supported by the Saxony-Anhalt Ministry of Economy, Science and Digitalization.
