The European Research Council (ERC) supports excellent investigator-driven frontier research across all fields of science, from Life Sciences via Physical and Engineering Sciences to Social Sciences and Humanities. The ERC offers attractive research grants for individual scientists. It supports researchers from two years after they have obtained their Ph.D. degrees, as well as scientists consolidating their independent research carriers and established excellent scientists (max. funding of 3.5 Million Euros over 5 years). ERC calls for proposals are open to researchers from around the world, who are planning to carry out their research at a host institution in Europe (European Union member states and associated countries). All research proposals submitted to the ERC are evaluated by internationally-composed expert review panels.

The presentation will put the ERC in context of other European funding opportunities, will explain the key features of ERC schemes and the evaluation process, and – with that – will inform the audience about what it takes to be a successful candidate for funding through this relatively new, prestigious European funding opportunity.
