

## Creative Europe



CREATIVE EUROPE is a program to promote the audiovisual industry in Europe as well as the cultural and creative industries. The program runs from 2014 to 2020 and has a budget of EUR 1.46 billion.

The goals of CREATIVE EUROPE are: to give projects European added value in order to increase their international success, to promote the professionalization of the actors on international territory and to open up new audiences.

With its three sub-programs MEDIA (for the audiovisual industry and game development), CULTURE (for other artistic discipline and CROSS-SECTOR (music and comprehensive student modules), it aims to support European cooperation projects, networks, platforms and literature translations as well as film distributors, festivals and international co-productions.

Cultural and artistic organizations and companies from EU countries, but also from different non-EU countries are eligible to apply.
