

EU4Health: Work Programme 2021 has been published

The European Commission has published the work programme for the new>EU4 Health Programme (https://ec.europa.eu/health/funding/eu4health_en) for 2021. In total, the EU will invest € 5.3 billion in the programme between 2021 and 2027. In addition to calls for proposals on COVID-19 and measures to better prepare for health crises, other health topics such *a*

prevention, early detection, diagnosis and treatment of cancer or rare diseases also play an important role.

The programme has 10 specific objectives, mapped to 4 general objectives:

1. Improving and promoting health in the Union

- Disease prevention and health promotion
- ► Health initiatives and cooperation at international level

2. Combating cross-border health threats

- ▶ Prevention, preparedness and rapid response with regard to cross-border health threats
- Supplementing national stockpiles with essential crisis-related products
- \blacktriangleright Establishment of a reserve of medical, health and support personnel

3. Improvements in pharmaceuticals, medical devices and crisis-related products

- ► Available and affordable medicines, medical devices and crisis-related products
- 4. Strengthening health systems, their resilience and resource efficiency
- ▶ Strengthening health data, digital tools and services; digitizing health systems
- Improving access to healthcare
- Developing and enforcing EU health law and evidence-based decision making
- Coordination between national health systems
